

Kids Artwork Frame Hanging Guidelines



All You Need is

1. Screws or Nails
2. Screwdriver or Hammer
3. Pencil for marking
4. Measurement tape

Instructions for Hanging

1) Decide on the desired **Location** for the picture frame on the wall

2) **Measure** the distance between the centers of the frame hangers.



3) **Mark** on the **Wall** the 2 center points

4) **Install** Screws or Nails on these Marks



5) Carefully **Hang** the picture frame from up to down onto the screws or nails (Horizontally or Vertically)

6) **Ensure** that it rests securely and is properly aligned

* For the kids' safety, the display is Plexiglass and not breakable glass



Notes & Tips

- The installation method and the hardware needs may differ depending on the wall type (drywall, wood wall, brick wall, etc)
 - **Look** for a suitable area that is spacious enough to accommodate the frame without being overcrowded by other elements
 - **Consider** the lighting  in the room and choose a spot that is well-lit to enhance the visibility and overall impact of the picture frame
 - **Ensure** that the chosen location provides good visibility for the picture frame. Avoid placing it in areas where it may be obstructed by furniture, doors, or other objects
 - In generally, it is recommended to hang picture frames at eye level, which is around 57-60 inches (145-152 cm) from the floor. However, if the wall has furniture or decorative pieces below this level, the frame should be adjusted accordingly to maintain balance and visual appeal
 - If you plan to hang multiple picture frames, ensure they are evenly spaced and aligned.
- While installing consider using a level and measuring tape to maintain balance and symmetry between the frames. Avoid clustering them too closely together or spreading them too far apart

Step-by-Step Guide



Artwork Storage

Insert the artwork pages under the 2 elastic straps

* it can store up to 100 pcs of standard Letter/A4 paper size

Artwork Display

- 1) Plan the layout- Lay the artwork on a table or flat surface to decide on the display arrangement
- 2) Open the frame by gently pulling it out while supporting the cabinet base
- 3) Rotate the Mat Board clips to the open position set
- 4) Open the Mat Board by pulling the handle strip
- 5) Place the artwork inside the frame
- 6) Make sure it's centered and according to your planned layout
- 7) Close the Mat Board
- 8) Rotate the Mat Board clips to the lock position
- 9) Close the frame

* Ensure to remove the protective stickers from both sides of the display. The best way to do it is by disassembling the Mat Board



Place the Label Tag on the frame

Option to add an Erasable label tag, which gives the display some info in a nice and gentle look.

How to:

- 1) Gently **Slide** the Label Tag into the space between the plexi-glass and the frame wood
- 2) **Write** the artist name or signature, or add information on what is currently **Displaying**
